

UConn Building Names Committee

The UConn Building Names Committee was created by a Board of Trustees' policy in 1998. The Building Names Committee is advisory to the President and the Board of Trustees via the Institutional Advancement Committee.

The President may consult the Building Names Committee for naming new buildings, naming buildings in honor of a distinguished person, and naming buildings for donors. The Building Names Committee may also consult on the naming of large rooms such as lecture halls and auditoriums. The Building Names Committee is not involved in the neutral names (ex: Modular Building 1) or campus areas (ex: streets, roads, fields).

The Building Names Committee meets three to four times a year to review name proposals. The University President appoints at least seven members to the Building Names Committee including the Chairperson. Members serve two-year terms with the Chairperson appointed annually. Membership includes representatives from alumni, current faculty, retired faculty, staff, and students (Undergraduate and Graduate students are selected by USG and GS, respectively).
